Administration of Medication at School

Sometimes it is necessary for students to have prescribed medicine given to them during the school day. Schools require medical authorisation from a prescribing health practitioner to administer **any** medication to students (including over-the-counter medications such as paracetamol, cough mixture or alternative medicines). If medication is required to be administered by staff during school hours a 'Request to Administer Medicine' form will need to be completed and signed by the prescribing health practitioner. These forms can be obtained at the office if the need arises.
