## Our initiatives include


- Daily Writing - Work on writing to build stamina (10-15 minutes per day).
- Provide reasonable adjustments and assistance to ensure equity and inclusiveness.
- Case Management of students to identify challenges and develop focused strategies to target improvement.
- Use the Sharratt's 5 Questions to ensure a line of sight in teaching, learning and assessment.
- Balanced writing programme - modelled, shared, guided and independent writing using I Do, We Do, You Do.
- Develop purposeful learning and bump it up walls.
- Student learning goals to align with English assessment, Australian Curriculum and literacy continuum.
- Co-construct Writing Success Criteria with students.
